



### How to make an easy almost maintenance free Terrarium

Step 1, you will need to purchase a 50L - 150L clear plastic storage tub with a lid, a spray bottle, a 12mm - 16mm drill bit or hole borer and some Perlite, they are very cheap from Target, bunnings and the reject shop and any gardening supplies store (\$10 - \$30) (perlite is available on our website)



Step 2, Fill the bottom 1 - 2 inch of your container with wet perlite (soak perlite in a bucket before use) and drill 4 holes on the longest side of the storage tub, 3 Holes one the short end, and 6 holes in the lid, above the line of perlite (a hole about every 20cm along the sides, and ends)

also drill some 2 - 3mm holes in the bottom of the tub for excess water drainage in the lowest points of the bottom

(Please note the bigger your container the more holes you will need, the above is for an 80L tub)



Step 3, Place your grow kit inside, with an X cut in the side of the Bag for oyster mushrooms, and sit back and watch, For shiitake remove bag after soaking and sit on some foil so the block is not directly on the perlite

All you need to do is mist inside once or twice a day and the perlite will do the rest,  
Tip - So long as there is water droplets on the walls and roof of your terrarium its humid enough for your mushrooms. - for any help please contact us at [info@aussimushroomsupplies.com](mailto:info@aussimushroomsupplies.com)
